

Proposed Route and Schedule Changes for March 4, 2019

The following route and schedule changes have been proposed by the Red Rose Transit Authority to be implemented on Monday, March 4, 2019.

A route by route description of the proposed changes is as follows:

Route 3/Park City C:

Propose to make minor time point adjustments to improve on-time performance. Propose to use Prince Street to Fairview Avenue to Hershey Avenue to Manor Street to Manor Shopping Center when not traveling to Sterling Place. When going to Sterling Place, use Hershey Avenue to Wabank Road to Sterling Place, then return to Hershey Avenue to Manor Street to Manor Shopping Center.

Historic Downtown Trolley:

Propose to eliminate Downtown Lancaster Trolley due to low ridership.

Route 10/Lititz:

Propose to make minor time point adjustments to improve on-time performance.

Route 11/Ephrata:

Propose to modify route to travel Route 272 (N. Reading Road) to Martin Avenue (servicing Wellspan Ephrata Community Hospital) to Main Street to regular route. Propose to have trips traveling to Ephrata Area Rehab Services (EARS), use Main Street to Park Avenue to Chestnut Street to Terrace Street to Main Street to regular route. All trips will serve Walmart.

Route 15/Willow Street:

Propose to modify route to travel outbound from Lancaster on Willow Street Pike to Locust Lane to Eshelman Mill Road to Beaver Valley Pike to Willow Valley Lakes Drive (into Willow Valley Lakes and Medical Center) to Kendig Road to Willow Street Pike to KMART at Kendig Square. Propose to travel inbound from Kendig Square to Beaver Valley Pike to Eshelman Mill Road to Locust Lane to regular route. Propose to adjust schedule to improve on-time performance.

Route 16/Millersville

Propose to modify route to travel outbound from Lancaster City on Orange Street to Charlotte Street to Manor Street to regular route. Propose to travel inbound from Millersville on Manor Street to King Street to regular route.

Route 17/Columbia:

Propose to modify route on all inbound and outbound Hempfield Industrial Park trips to travel Columbia Avenue to Rohrerstown Road to Knoll Drive to Oak Tree Drive to regular route.

Route 20/Greenfield:

Propose to eliminate the 6:15 pm, 7:00 pm, 7:40 pm, 8:20 pm, & 9:00 pm trips. Propose to modify route to stop at Greenfield Corporate Center first, then PA College of Health Sciences.

Route 21/Gap:

Propose to make minor time point adjustments to improve on-time performance.

A public hearing to review the proposed Route and Schedule Changes is scheduled for Tuesday, January 15, 2019 between 4:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. at RRTA's Operations Center, 45 Erick Road, Lancaster.
