Our Services

The Red Rose Transit Authority provides comprehensive public transportation services throughout Lancaster County. These include Red Rose Transit, our fixed route bus service that operates 17 routes and Red Rose Access, our county-wide shared ride, paratransit service operated by a private transportation provider.

Our Board

South Central Transit Authority (SCTA) is the management organization that oversees RRTA services in Lancaster, PA & BARTA in Reading, PA. SCTA Board meetings are held at 6 PM on the third Wednesday of the month and rotate between the Lancaster and Reading offices. On holidays, Saturdays and Sundays when RRTA offices are closed, please call 717-291-1243 to leave a message or schedule a trip eligible under ADA.

RRTA provides several options to assist communicating with individuals who do not speak English. RRTA contracts with Language Line Solutions to provide translation services. Customers should identify their need upon calling RRTA and RRTA will conference call in the interpreter.

For individuals who are hearing impaired, RRTA encourages customers to use PA Relay Service. This service can be accessed by calling 711. The translation and interpretation are free.

Holiday Closings

Red Rose Transit and Red Rose Access do not provide service on the following holidays: New Year's Day, Easter, Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day.

Lost and Found

If an item is lost on a bus and retrieved by our drivers, the driver is required to hand-in the lost item to either RRTA's Queen Street Station or The Operations Center, 45 Erick Road, Lancaster. All items are logged. If the item is not claimed at Queen Street Station the first day it is lost, it will be sent to The Operations Center to be claimed. If you lose an item on our buses, call RRTA at 717-397-4246. All items are kept for 7 days. This procedure is followed to ensure the proper owner receives their lost item.



Queen Street Station Transit Center

Queen Street Station, RRTA's Downtown Lancaster transit center, offers a clean, safe, easy-to-use transit park for customers waiting for or transferring to many RRTA routes. The urban park includes shelters and benches in a landscaped plaza for customers waiting for the bus.

The Information Center at Queen Street Station provides a location for customers to purchase passes and request schedule information. A waiting area and snack machine are available for customers.

Centro de tránsito de la estación Queen Street

Queen Street Station, el centro de tránsito del centro de Lancaster de la RRTA, ofrece un parque de tránsito limpio, seguro y fácil de usar para los clientes que esperan o hacen transbordo a muchas rutas de la RRTA. El parque urbano incluye marquesinas y bancos en una plaza ajardinada para los clientes que esperan el autobús.

El Centro de información en la estación Queen Street ofrece un lugar para que los clientes compren pases y soliciten información sobre horarios. Hay una zona de espera y una máquina de snacks a disposición de los clientes.

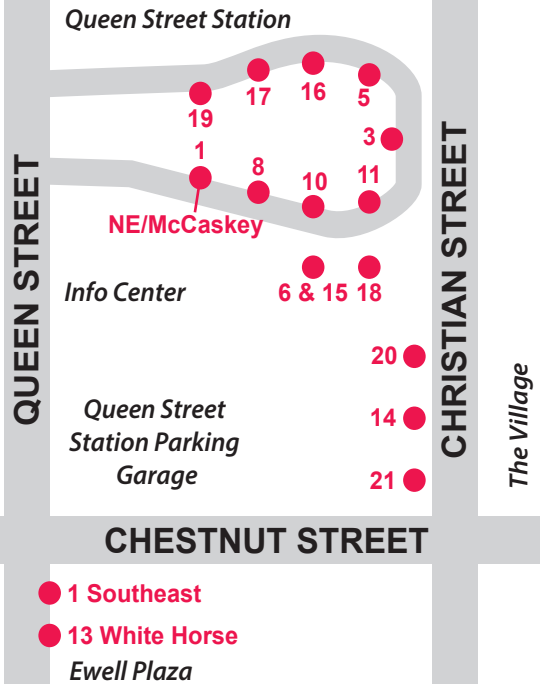

Adult Cash Fare: \$1.80

Grades K-12. High school students must show valid student ID.

Children age 5 and under: FREE

*when accompanied by a full fare paying passenger.

All Day Passes

The All Day Pass provides unlimited rides for one day.

All Day Pass: \$3.70

Note: All Day Passes are available for purchase at the farebox. Please tell the driver prior to inserting money into the farebox.

10 Ride Passes

10 Ride Passes are good for 10 one-way trips and do not expire.

Adult 10 Ride Pass: \$13.50

Student 10 Ride Pass: \$9.00

Half Fare 10 Ride Pass: \$6.75

31 Day Passes

31 Day Passes offer unlimited rides in a 31-day period. The 31-day time period begins the first time the pass is activated.

Adult 31 Day Pass: \$42.00

Student 31 Day Pass: \$20.00



Special Discounts

Half Fare Program - Persons with Disabilities ride for half fare any time. Customers can apply for a Half Fare ID card, available from RRTA, for persons with a qualifying disability. Persons under 65 with a Medicare card may qualify for this program. A Half Fare ID card or Medicare Card must be shown to receive the cash fare discount at the time of boarding. Applications are available on-line or by calling to request one in the mail.

Senior Citizens: Age 65 or older, may ride FREE any time on any RRTA bus route. A PA Transit ID Card is valid proof to ride. See Page 59 for details on how to apply.

Transfers

Transfers: No Charge.

Paying in Cash: If you have to transfer from one bus to another to complete your one-way trip, ask the driver of the first bus for a transfer slip when you pay your fare if you are paying in cash.

Paying with Go Mobile app or Go Mobile card: Transfers will occur automatically.

If the time to connect to your second bus is close, please ask the driver to notify dispatch to inform the driver of the second bus to expect you. Buses can only be held five minutes for transfer connections. **The transfer cannot be used for a return trip on the same or nearby routes.** All transfers must take place in Downtown Lancaster.

Transfers are time stamped and must be used prior to the expiration time. Transfers are valid up to two hours.

Customers attempting to connect with other buses must be scheduled to arrive at or before the time of the departing bus. This is a legal transfer. If the bus is not scheduled to arrive before the connecting bus is scheduled to leave, the connecting bus will not be held.

Descuentos Especiales

Programa de mitad de tarifa: las personas con discapacidades viajan a mitad de tarifa en cualquier momento. Los clientes pueden solicitar una tarjeta de identificación de mitad de tarifa, disponible en RRTA, para personas con una discapacidad que califique. Las personas menores de 65 años con una tarjeta de Medicare pueden calificar para este programa. Se debe mostrar una tarjeta de identificación de mitad de tarifa o una tarjeta de Medicare para recibir el descuento de tarifa en efectivo al momento de abordar. Las solicitudes están disponibles en línea o llamando para solicitar una por correo.

Ciudadanos mayores: 65 años o más, pueden viajar GRATIS en cualquier momento en cualquier ruta de autobús RRTA. Una tarjeta de identificación de PA Transit es una prueba válida para viajar. Consulte la página 59 para obtener detalles sobre cómo presentar la solicitud.

Transferencias

Transferencias: Sin Cargo.

Pago en efectivo: si tiene que hacer transbordo de un autobús a otro para completar su viaje de ida, solicite al conductor del primer autobús un comprobante de transbordo cuando pague su tarifa si paga en efectivo.

Pagar con la aplicación Go Mobile o la tarjeta Go Mobile: las transferencias se realizarán automáticamente.

Si el tiempo para conectarse a su segundo autobús está cerca, pídale al conductor que notifique al despacho para informarle del segundo autobús que lo espera. Los autobuses solo pueden demorar cinco minutos para las conexiones de transbordo. El transfer no se puede utilizar para un viaje de regreso en la misma ruta o en rutas cercanas. Todos los traslados deben realizarse en el centro de Lancaster.

Las transferencias tienen una marca de tiempo y deben usarse antes de la fecha de vencimiento. Los traslados son válidos hasta dos horas.

Los clientes que intenten conectarse con otros autobuses deben tener programado llegar a la hora de salida del autobús o antes. Esta es una transferencia legal. Si el autobús no está programado para llegar antes de la salida programada del autobús de conexión, el autobús de conexión no se retendrá.

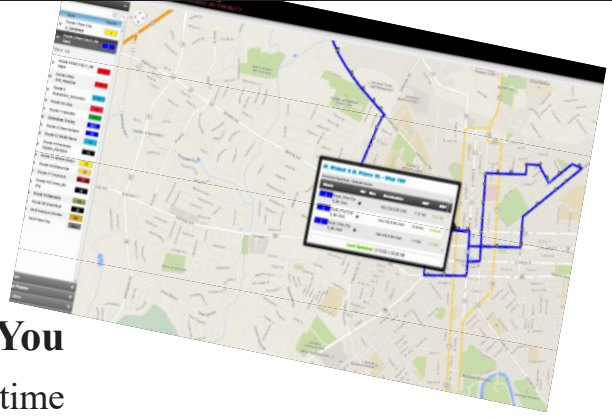

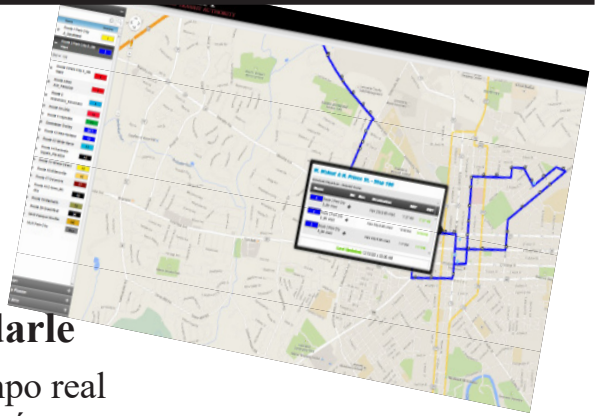

Bike 'n Ride

Three Easy Steps to Use the Bike Rack

Step 1: Lower Rack

Squeeze center handle and pull rack down.

Step 2: Load Bike

Place bike in one of the two bike spaces

Step 3: Secure Wheel

Pull the security arm over the bike's wheel to keep in place. The only contact is with the wheel of the bike so there is no damage to the bike frame.

Each passenger is responsible to place their bike on the bus and take the bike off of the bus. When finished using the bike rack and the rack is empty, please place it in the folded position.



E-BIKE POLICY



Electric bicycles that securely fit the bike rack will be transported.



Electric bicycles with tires that do not completely fit inside the bike rack tire sleeves cannot be safely transported.



ELECTRIC BICYCLES MAY NOT BE TRANSPORTED INSIDE A BUS UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES.

E-SCOOTER POLICY



Electric Scooters are allowed on the bus as long as they are folded.



Electric Mobility Scooters are allowed on the bus as long as they are secured with straps.



Bicicleta y paseo

Tres sencillos pasos para utilizar el portabicicletas

Paso 1: Rejilla Inferior

Apriete la manija central y baje la rejilla.

Paso 2: Cargar Bicicleta

Coloque la bicicleta en uno de los dos espacios para bicicletas.

Paso 3: Rueda Segura

Pase el brazo de seguridad sobre la rueda de la bicicleta para mantenerlo en su lugar. El único contacto es con la rueda de la bicicleta para que no se dañe el cuadro de la bicicleta.



Cada pasajero es responsable de colocar su bicicleta en el autobús y bajarla del autobús. Cuando termine de usar el portabicicletas y esté vacío, colóquelo en la posición plegada.

Se transportarán bicicletas eléctricas que se ajusten de forma segura al portabicicletas.

Los patinetes eléctricos están permitidos en el autobús siempre que estén plegados.



Los scooters de movilidad eléctrica están permitidos en el autobús siempre que estén asegurados con correas.



How to Ride RRTA Buses



1. Locate a Bus Stop

RRTA bus stop signs are placed throughout Lancaster City and County along our routes. If you live in Lancaster City, locate the nearest bus stop for your route and wait for the bus to come to your stop. Outside Lancaster City, if

no bus stop sign is nearby, wait on the same side of the street as the bus travels. Wait at a safe area and “flag” (wave to) the driver as the vehicle approaches. Please be at the bus stop at least 5 minutes prior to the scheduled arrival of the bus.

2. Identify Your Bus

Each RRTA bus is identified by a route number and name, for example, “Route 10/Lititz.” Each bus indicates the route number and/or name on the outside of the bus so it is easy to determine which route it is.

3. Board Your Bus

- Remember to stand in clear view of the driver and wave as the bus approaches if you are not at a marked bus stop. Waving to the driver is also helpful while standing at a marked bus stop to let the driver know you would like to board that particular bus. You may wave a flashlight to ensure the driver sees you waiting in the dark.
- If you find it difficult to climb the front steps of the bus, ask the driver to lower the bus for you. Our buses have a special “kneeling feature” which lowers the first step to curb level.

- If you see a bus coming toward you that isn’t the one you want, wave the driver on.
- Let departing passengers off before you try to board.

4. Pay Your Fare

Fares are paid when you board any RRTA bus. If you are paying in cash you must have exact change. If you are transferring from one bus to another to complete your one-way trip and are paying in cash, ask the driver for a transfer slip when you board. The transfer slip helps you save money on the second bus. Customers can also pay their fare by using the RRTA Go Mobile App on their phone or using a RRTA Go Mobile card. For customers using mobile payment, transfers will occur automatically in the app.

5. Exit Your Bus

Usually drivers will bypass stops where no one is waiting, unless someone signals to get off. As the bus approaches within one block of your stop, signal the driver by pulling the cord or red stop buttons, which are located on both sides of the bus or on the railings along the aisle.

In Lancaster City, passengers must get on and off at marked bus stops signs. Outside Lancaster City passengers may get on and off along the route, even if there is no marked bus stop sign.

ALL BUSES ARE WHEELCHAIR ACCESSIBLE



For the safety of all passengers, RRTA requires operators to secure all mobility devices with proper 4-point securement before transport.

Como Viajar en los Autobuses de la RRTA



1. Localize Su Parada

Hay señales de paradas de autobús RRTA colocadas en toda la ciudad y el condado de Lancaster a lo largo de nuestras rutas. Si vive en la ciudad de Lancaster, busque la parada de autobús más cercana a su ruta y espere a que el autobús llegue a su parada. Fuera

de Lancaster City, si no hay una señal de parada de autobús cerca, espere en el mismo lado de la calle por donde viaja el autobús. Espere en un área segura y “señale” (saluda) al conductor cuando el vehículo se acerque. Esté en la parada de autobús al menos 5 minutos antes de la llegada programada del autobús.

2. Identifique Su Autobús

Cada autobús RRTA está identificado por un número y nombre de la ruta, por ejemplo, “Ruta 10/Lititz”. Cada autobús indica el número de ruta y/o nombre en el exterior del autobús para que sea fácil determinar qué ruta es

3. Aborde Su Autobús

- Recuerde permanecer a la vista del conductor y saludar cuando el autobús se acerque. Si no se encuentra en una parada de autobús señalizada. Saludar al conductor también es útil mientras estás parado en una parada de autobús marcada para informarle que deseas abordar ese autobús en particular. Puede agitar una linterna para asegurarse de que el conductor lo vea esperando en la oscuridad.
- Si le resulta difícil subir los escalones delanteros del autobús, pídale al conductor que baje el autobús por usted. Nuestros autobuses tienen una

“función de arrodillarse” especial que baja el primer escalón hasta el nivel de la acera.

- Si ve un autobús viniendo hacia usted ese no es el que quiere, agita el conductor encendido.
- Deje bajar a los pasajeros que salen antes de intentar abordar.

4. Pague Su Tarifa

Las tarifas se pagan al abordar cualquier RRTA autobús. Si paga en efectivo debe tener cambio exacto. Si estas transfiriendo de un autobús a otro para completar tu viaje solo ida y pagas en efectivo, pregunta al conductor un comprobante de transferencia cuando junta. El recibo de transferencia te ayuda a ahorrar dinero en el segundo autobús. Los clientes pueden también pagar su tarifa utilizando el RRTA Go Aplicación móvil en su teléfono o usando un Tarjeta RRTA Go Mobile. Para clientes Al utilizar el pago móvil, las transferencias ocurren automáticamente en la aplicación.

5. Llegue a Su Destino

Usualmente, los conductores pasarán por alto las paradas donde no hay nadie esperando, a menos de que alguien indique que se quiere bajar. Cuando el autobús esté a una cuadra de distancia de su parada, hale el cordón ó presione las cintas amarillas ubicadas a cada lado del autobús.

En la ciudad de Lancaster, los pasajeros deben subir y bajar en las señales de parada de autobús marcadas. Fuera de la ciudad de Lancaster, los pasajeros pueden subir y bajar a lo largo de la ruta, incluso si no hay ninguna señal de parada marcada.



Para la seguridad de todos los pasajeros, RRTA requiere que los operadores aseguren todos los dispositivos de movilidad con la seguridad adecuada de 4 puntos antes del transporte.

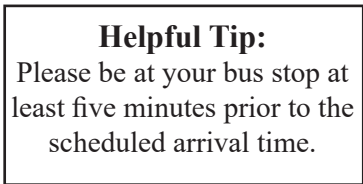
Here are some tips to make reading our schedules easier.

The route always runs from left to right. The map and schedule are also read from left to right.

Be sure to look at the correct side of the schedule. Some schedules have a weekday and weekend page. Our County routes have an inbound and outbound side.

The bus stops are noted with numbers on the route map that match the numbered columns (timepoints) below the map in the time section. These timepoints note when the bus will be at that specific location. There are many bus stops in between the time points. Times for bus stops not listed can be estimated by looking at the previous timepoint.

If there are any special deviations from the regular route they are noted in a box on the map with a corresponding letter. The letter is noted in the time section when it will occur.



Timepoints

Not all bus stops are listed on the schedules. There are many bus stops in between the listed timepoints. Customers can estimate the time the bus will arrive at a bus stop not shown on the schedule.

Also, drivers must wait at the timepoints until the scheduled time before they move onto the next bus stop along the route.

Cómo Leer un Horario

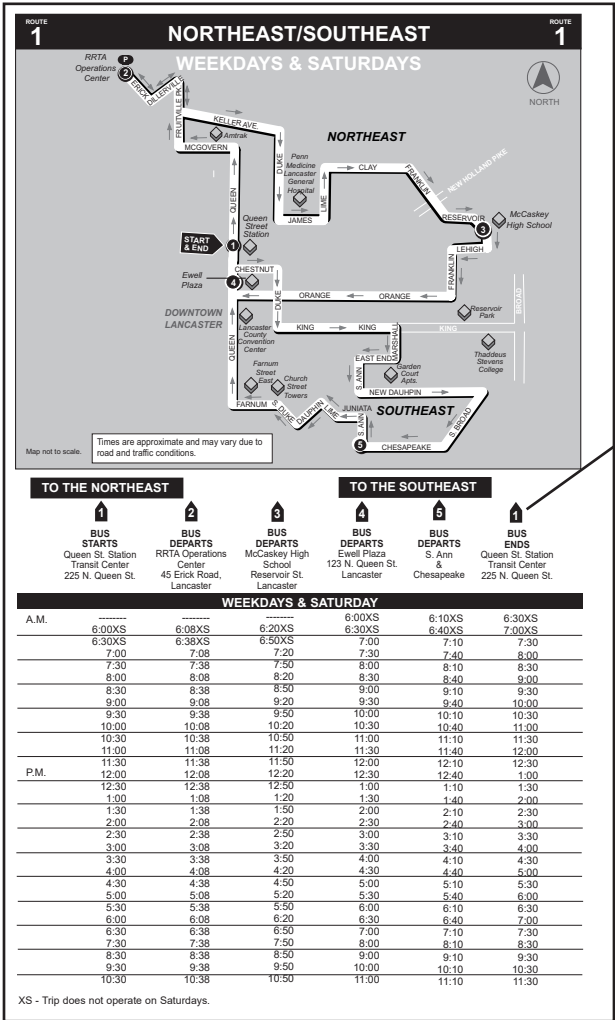
A continuación se ofrecen algunos consejos para facilitar la lectura de nuestros horarios.

La ruta siempre discurre de izquierda a derecha. El mapa y el horario también se leen de izquierda a derecha.

Asegúrese de mirar el lado correcto del horario. Algunos horarios tienen una página de días laborables y de fin de semana. Las rutas de nuestro condado tienen un lado de entrada y de salida.

Las paradas de autobús están marcadas con números en el mapa de ruta que coinciden con las columnas numeradas (puntos de tiempo) debajo del mapa en la sección de tiempo. Estos puntos de tiempo indican cuándo estará el autobús en ese lugar específico. Hay muchas paradas de autobús entre los puntos horarios. Los tiempos de las paradas de autobús que no figuran en la lista se pueden estimar observando el punto de tiempo anterior.

Si hay alguna desviación especial de la ruta regular se anota en un recuadro en el mapa con la letra correspondiente. La carta se anota en la sección de tiempo en la que ocurrirá.



BE NICE and Ride with Respect



An Enjoyable Riding Experience is our goal for every customer and that all starts with RESPECT. Our Customer Code of Conduct calls on riders to treat everyone the way they want to be treated.

Our Customer Code of Conduct

The following are prohibited on RRTA property and vehicles:

- Spitting, littering, indecent exposure, stealing/damaging RRTA property and disorderly conduct.
- Avoid abusive, threatening or obscene language.
- Disturbing or harassing other passengers or the driver.
- Bringing animals (any pets besides service animals). However, small pets in pet carriers are permitted.
- Smoking tobacco — even electronic cigarettes.
- No food or drink permitted on buses.
- Playing music is permitted only if you have ear buds or headphones that prevent your music from bothering others on RRTA. Turn off the speaker function while riding.
- It's illegal to avoid paying RRTA fare, whether by skipping payment or using counterfeit fare.
- It's also illegal to bring explosives, fuel containers of any kind or other potentially dangerous objects on RRTA property or buses.
- Selling goods or services isn't allowed on RRTA, this includes giving out commercial hand bills and flyers to passengers on buses.
- Strollers, umbrellas and carts must be folded while boarding the bus.

Being respectful of the people around you and being considerate to fellow riders and operators doesn't take more than common courtesy.

And common courtesy is all we ask from our riders.

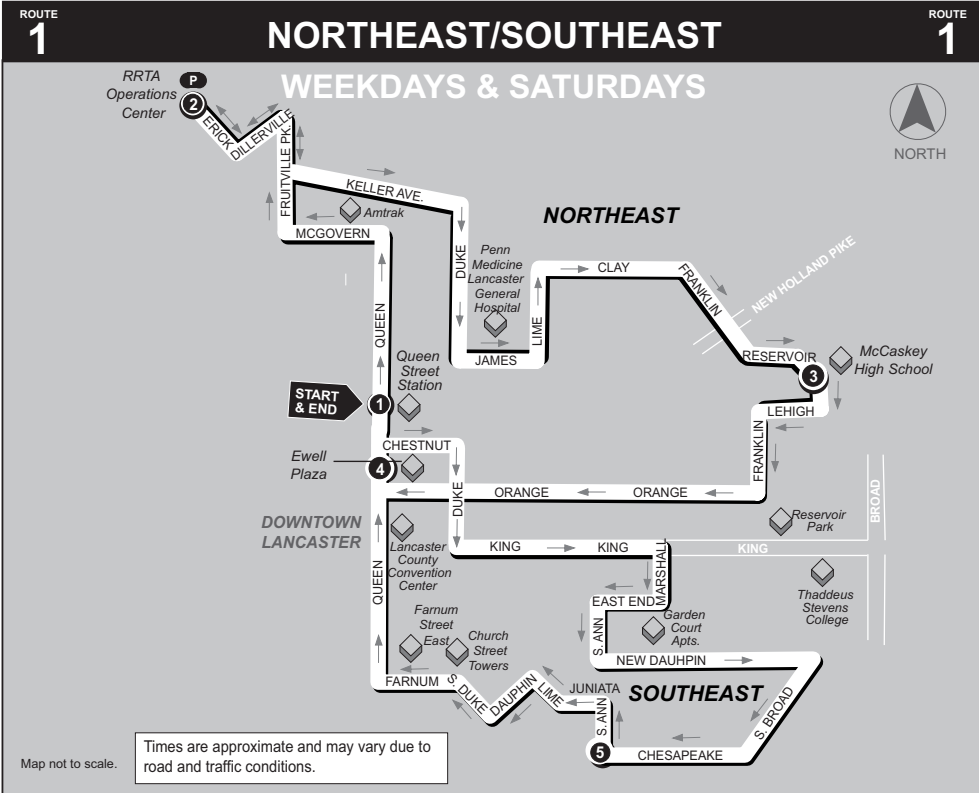
Una experiencia de conducción agradable es nuestro objetivo para cada cliente y todo comienza con RESPETO. Nuestro Código de conducta del cliente exige a los pasajeros que traten a todos como quieren que los traten.

Nuestro Código de Conducta del Cliente

Lo siguiente está prohibido en propiedades y vehículos de RRTA:

- Escupir, tirar basura, exhibicionismo, robar/dañar propiedad de RRTA y conducta desordenada.
- Evite el lenguaje abusivo, amenazante u obsceno.
- Molestar o acosar a otros pasajeros o al conductor.
- Traer animales (cualquier mascota además de los animales de servicio). Sin embargo, se permiten mascotas pequeñas en transportadores.
- Fumar tabaco, incluso cigarrillos electrónicos.
- No se permite comida ni bebida en los autobuses.
- Se permite reproducir música solo si tiene audífonos o audífonos que eviten que su música moleste a otros en RRTA. Apague la función de altavoz mientras conduce.

The MU Xpress and the Route 16/Millersville bus routes are FREE for MU students and faculty when school is in session.

- The **MU Xpress** - On-Campus Shuttle to get around the campus during weekdays.
- The **RRTA Route 16/Millersville** bus route that serves Millersville Borough to Downtown Lancaster. Provides close access to The Ware Center.

Both of these bus routes are FREE when a student or faculty member uses an RRTA Go Mobile card that is designated for the MU Service. Students and Faculty can get RRTA Go Mobile cards at the information desk in the Student Memorial Center. Students and faculty must bring their University ID card to receive the free RRTA Go Mobile card.

The MU FREE service is only valid when MU is in session during the Fall and Spring semesters. The MU Xpress is open to the public and regular fare applies. RRTA will not operate the MU Xpress when Millersville is not in session. The Route 16/Millersville bus route will operate its normal schedule throughout the year. Students will have to pay regular fare on the RRTA Route 16/Millersville bus route when MU is not in session.

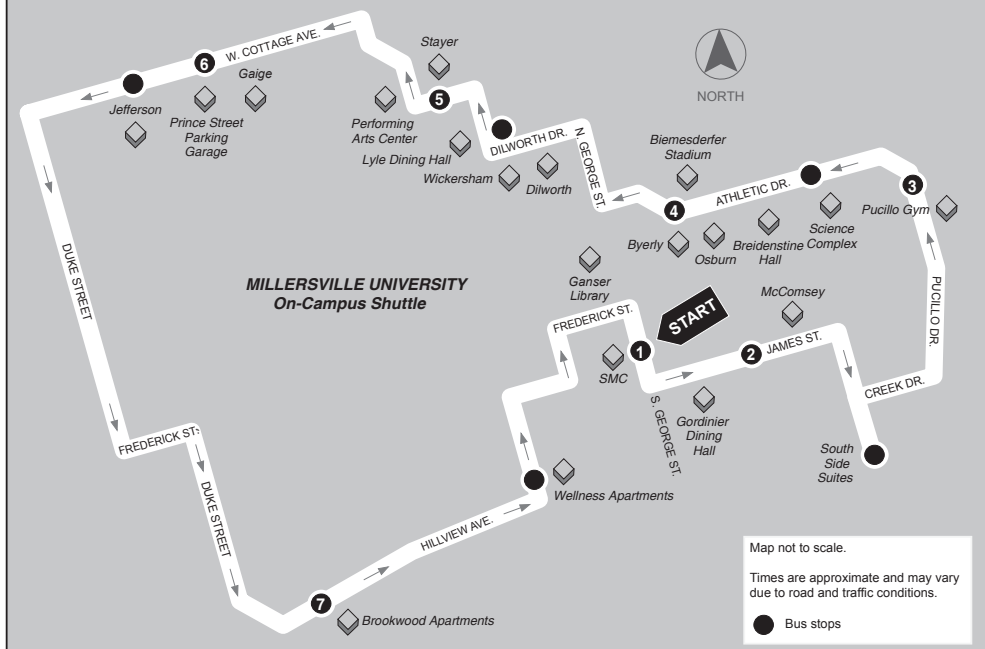

Be Involved in a Lifesaving Partnership: Transit Employees & Passengers

As a resource, transit employees provide a wealth of specialized knowledge and on-the-job experience. Likewise, transit passengers contribute to the security equation by providing thousands of extra eyes and ears capable of identifying possible life-threatening situations.

When transit employees and transit passengers pool these resources, the result is a highly effective, first line of defense against a potential natural or man-made disaster. Please make a commitment to becoming an alert, informed, prepared and involved member of this employee-passenger partnership. Rest assured, your efforts will go a long way toward enhancing the safety and security of our transit system.

Be Informed & Have a Transit Plan of Action

- Familiarize yourself with station entrances
- Remain calm and listen for any bus announcements
- Follow transit authority instructions in a speedy but orderly fashion

- Do not block bus doors from closing
- Assist fellow passengers and follow the Golden Rule: Watch out for the safety of others just as you would have them watch out for your safety

Be on Alert for Suspicious Packages

If you spot an unattended package, look for the following:

- Placement in an out-of-the-way location
- Individuals in the act of abandoning the package and hastily departing the area
- Unusual attached batteries, wires, tanks, bottles or bags that might contain chemicals
- A suspicious cloud, mist, gas, vapor, odor or seeping fluid
- Nearby individuals showing signs of illness or distress

Be on Alert for Suspicious Behavior

If you spot any suspicious individuals engaged in questionable activity, look for the following:

- Visible signs of nervousness
- Excessive sweating
- Sprayer bottles or aerosol canisters
- Inappropriate clothing that is excessively baggy or too heavy in warm weather.

Do not confront suspicious individuals. Contact a transit employee or the police immediately.

Access to Jobs

Need help with transportation during 2nd & 3rd shift work times?

RRTA's Access to Jobs program may be able to help. The Access to Jobs program is a unique program that uses both RRTA's bus route services and shared-ride services to help workers who need late night transportation. The goal of the program is to have eligible customers use RRTA's bus service for one portion of their commute. The other portion of their commute is provided through RRTA's shared-ride service during times when the bus routes are not operating.

RRTA's Bus Route Service

The first portion of the Access to Jobs program encourages approved customers to use RRTA's bus routes for out part of their commute. RRTA provides 17 bus routes throughout Lancaster County. Access to Jobs customers would use a bus route to get them to or from work.

RRTA's Shared Ride Service

The second portion of the Access to Jobs program is through RRTA's shared-ride service to provide transportation during 2nd and 3rd work times when RRTA's bus routes are not operating. The metro area is approximately a 10 mile radius of Lancaster City and service is provided through our shared ride carrier Easton Coach Co.

Who is Eligible for the Program?

If you meet the requirements, you must fill out an application to be enrolled in the program. The following requirements must be met to be enrolled in the program:

Program Requirements:

- You must need transportation to or from work.
- You must live and work within 1/4 mile of a RRTA bus route
- You must live and travel within a 10 mile radius of Lancaster City
- Your trip must be during times not provided by our fixed-route service in your area.
- Your household income must be within 150% of the federal poverty level.

To receive an application contact RRTA at 291-1243. The application process takes about 7 to 10 business days for acceptance.

Acceso a Empleos

¿Necesita ayuda con el transporte durante los horarios de trabajo del segundo y tercer turno?

El programa Acceso a Empleos de RRTA puede ayudar. El programa Acceso a Empleos es un programa único que utiliza tanto los servicios de ruta de autobús de RRTA como los servicios de viaje compartido para ayudar a los trabajadores que necesitan transporte nocturno. El objetivo del programa es que los clientes elegibles utilicen el servicio de autobús de RRTA durante una parte de su viaje. La otra parte de su viaje se realiza a través del servicio de viaje compartido de RRTA durante los momentos en que las rutas de autobús no están operativas.

Servicio de ruta de autobús de RRTA

La primera parte del programa Acceso a Empleos alienta a los clientes aprobados a utilizar las rutas de autobús de RRTA durante parte de su viaje. RRTA ofrece 17 rutas de autobús en todo el condado de Lancaster. Los clientes de Access to Jobs utilizarían una ruta de autobús para ir o volver del trabajo.

Servicio de viaje compartido RRTA

La segunda parte del programa Acceso a Empleos es a través del servicio de viaje compartido de RRTA para brindar transporte durante el segundo y tercer horario de trabajo cuando las rutas de autobús de RRTA no están operando. El área metropolitana está aproximadamente en un radio de 10 millas de la ciudad de Lancaster y el servicio se brinda a través de nuestra empresa de viajes compartidos Easton Coach Co.

¿Quién es elegible para el programa?

Si cumples con los requisitos, deberás llenar una solicitud para poder inscribirte en el programa. Se deben cumplir los siguientes requisitos para poder inscribirse en el programa:

Program Requirements:

- Debe necesitar transporte hacia o desde el trabajo
- Debes vivir y trabajar dentro
- 1/4 de milla de una ruta de autobús RRTA
- Debe vivir y viajar dentro de un radio de 10 millas de la ciudad de Lancaster.
- Su viaje debe realizarse en horarios no proporcionados por nuestro servicio de ruta fija en su área.
- Los ingresos de su hogar deben estar dentro del 150% del nivel federal de pobreza.

Para recibir una solicitud, comuníquese con RRTA al 291-1243. El proceso de solicitud demora entre 7 y 10 días hábiles para su aceptación.

Red Rose Transit Wheelchair Accessible Bus Service...

All RRTA buses used for our fixed route service are fully accessible in accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) of 1990. These features include:

- Driver-operated wheelchair ramps
- “Kneeling” capability. Our drivers can lower the front door to make boarding easier
- Ample space in the front of the bus to accommodate wheelchairs

Should a person with a disability be unable to board these buses or need to travel more than 3/4 mile to or from an RRTA bus stop, we also offer Red Rose Access, a shared ride program, which offers door-to-door transit service.

Red Rose Access Shared Ride Service...

Who Is Eligible?

Individuals who have a disability may be eligible for shared ride transportation with Red Rose Access if their disability prevents them from independently boarding an RRTA bus. ADA requires transportation to be provided within 3/4 of a mile radius of fixed-route bus service. If there is no fixed-route bus service, transportation is not required.

Applying for the ADA Shared-Ride Program

An application must be completed to determine eligibility. An application may be completed on-line by visiting www.redrosetransit.com or by calling (717) 291-1243 and a customer service representative will mail the application.

RRTA provides several options to assist communicating with individuals who do not speak English. RRTA

contracts with Language Line Solutions to provide translation services. RRTA will conference call in the interpreter.

For individuals who are hearing impaired, RRTA encourages customers to use the PA Relay Service. This service can be accessed by calling 711. The translation and interpretation services are free of charge.

In Person: Applications may also be obtained and completed at:

The RRTA Information Center at Queen Street Station, 225 N. Queen St., Lancaster or the RRTA Operations Center, 45 Erick Rd., Lancaster.

A physician must certify the applicant's disability for program approval.

How Quickly Can An ADA Complementary Shared-Ride Application Be Processed?

Within 21 days of receiving an ADA application for service, RRTA is required to make a determination of eligibility.

Scheduling a Trip?

Trip reservations may be scheduled by calling (717) 291-1243 between 7:30 a.m. and 5:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. Trips must be scheduled at least one day in advance. Service is generally available Monday through Friday, the earliest is 4:50 a.m. to the latest 11:10 p.m. Saturday the earliest is 5:40 a.m. to 11:10 p.m. Sunday the earliest is 7:15 a.m. to the latest 7:15 p.m. for trips where the pick-up address and destination are located within 3/4 miles of the fixed-route bus service.

In accordance with the ADA, RRTA may be required to adjust your scheduled pick

up to coordinate with other customer requests.

When calling to schedule a trip, please have the following information ready:

- The address where the customer wants to be picked up
- The full address of the final destination
- The appointment and return time
- Any special assistance requirements
- Customers should be ready early and wait for the driver at the exact address given when making the reservation. Customers should wait where you can see the vehicle approach. The drivers can wait only 5 minutes.

How Much Does It Cost To Ride?

ADA Certified individuals will pay no more than twice the fare of someone riding the same route on an RRTA fixed-route bus. Payments are due at time of boarding the vehicle.

Can I travel with a friend?

A companion may travel with a customer at no charge. Additional companions will be permitted if space is available. If approved during the application process, a Personal Care Attendant (PCA) may ride with the customer to assist with their mobility needs; the PCA will ride at no cost.

How to Cancel a Trip?

Customers should call as soon as they know that they are no longer need their trip. If customers must cancel on the same day the trip is scheduled, call (717) 291-1243 at least 45 minutes prior to the scheduled pick-up time. After office hours and weekends, please call Easton Coach Co. at 717-396-1001.

Out of Town Visitors for ADA

If a visitor does not have ADA eligibility documentation from another jurisdiction, RRTA will still provide service. RRTA may request proof of residency, and if the disability is not apparent, documentation of the individual's disability. RRTA will accept a certification by the visitor that he or she is unable to use fixed route transit. This means that RRTA cannot require documentation beyond the visitor's "say so" that he or she cannot use the fixed-route system. Services are provided for any combination of 21 days during any 365-day period beginning with the visitor's first use of the service during that 365-day period. Reservations can be made using the same process as approved paratransit riders.



Servicio de autobús accesible para sillas de ruedas de Red Rose Transit...

Todos los autobuses RRTA utilizados para nuestro servicio de ruta fija son totalmente accesibles de acuerdo con la Ley de Estadounidenses con Discapacidades (ADA) de 1990. Estas características incluyen:

- Rampas para sillas de ruedas operadas por el conductor
- Capacidad de “arrodillarse”. Nuestros conductores pueden bajar la puerta principal para facilitar el embarque.
- Amplio espacio en la parte delantera del autobús para acomodar sillas de ruedas.

Si una persona con discapacidad no puede abordar estos autobuses o necesita viajar más de 3/4 de milla hacia o desde una parada de autobús RRTA, también ofrecemos Red Rose Access, un programa de viaje compartido, que ofrece transporte puerta a puerta. servicio.

Servicio de viaje compartido Red Rose Access...

¿Quién es elegible?

Las personas que tienen una discapacidad pueden ser elegible para transporte compartido con Red Rose Access si su discapacidad les impide abordar de forma independiente un autobús RRTA. La ADA exige que el transporte se proporcione dentro de un radio de 3/4 de milla del servicio de autobús de ruta fija. Si no hay servicio de autobús de ruta fija, no se requiere transporte.

Solicitar el programa de viaje compartido ADA

Se debe completar una solicitud para determinar la elegibilidad. Se puede completar una solicitud en línea visitando www.redrosetransit.com o llamando al (717) 291-1243 y un representante de servicio al cliente le enviará la solicitud por correo.

Para las personas con problemas de audición, RRTA recomienda a los clientes que utilicen el servicio de retransmisión de PA. Se puede acceder a este servicio llamando al 711. Los servicios de traducción e interpretación son gratuitos.

En persona: las solicitudes también se pueden obtener y completar en:

El Centro de información de RRTA en Queen Street Station, 225 N. Queen St., Lancaster o el Centro de operaciones de RRTA, 45 Erick Rd., Lancaster.

Un médico debe certificar la discapacidad del solicitante para la aprobación del programa.

¿Con qué rapidez se puede procesar una solicitud de viaje compartido complementario ADA?

Dentro de los 21 días posteriores a la recepción de una solicitud de servicio ADA, la RRTA debe tomar una determinación de elegibilidad.

¿Programando un viaje?

Las reservaciones de viajes se pueden programar llamando al (717) 291-1243 entre las 7:30 a. m. y las 5:30 p. m., de lunes a viernes. Los viajes deben programarse con al menos un día de antelación. El servicio generalmente está disponible de lunes a viernes, desde las 4:50 a. m. más temprano hasta las 11:10 p. m. más

tarde. El sábado lo más temprano es de 5:40 a. m. a 11:10 p. m. El domingo, lo más temprano es a las 7:15 a. m. y lo más tarde a las 7:15 p. m. para viajes donde la dirección de recogida y el destino se encuentran dentro de 3/4 de milla del servicio de autobús de ruta fija.

De acuerdo con la ADA, es posible que se requiera que la RRTA ajuste su selección programada hasta coordinar con otras solicitudes de clientes.

Cuando llame para programar un viaje, tenga a mano la siguiente información:

- La dirección donde el cliente quiere ser recogido.
- La dirección completa del destino final.
- La cita y hora de regreso.
- Cualquier requisito de asistencia especial
- Los clientes deben estar listos con anticipación y esperar al conductor en la dirección exacta indicada al realizar la reserva. Los clientes deben esperar donde puedan ver acercarse el vehículo. Los conductores pueden esperar sólo 5 minutos.

¿Cuánto cuesta viajar?

Las personas certificadas por la ADA no pagarán más del doble de la tarifa de alguien que viaje en la misma ruta en un autobús de ruta fija de la RRTA. Los pagos vencen al momento de abordar el vehículo.

¿Puedo viajar con un amigo?

Un acompañante podrá viajar con un cliente sin coste alguno. Se permitirán acompañantes adicionales si hay espacio disponible. Si se aprueba durante el proceso de solicitud, un asistente de cuidado personal (PCA)

puede viajar con el cliente para ayudarlo con sus necesidades de movilidad; la PCA viajará sin costo alguno.

¿Cómo cancelar un viaje?

Los clientes deben llamar tan pronto como sepan que ya no necesitan su viaje. Si los clientes deben cancelar el mismo día del viaje programado, llame al (717) 291-1243 al menos 45 minutos antes de la hora de recogida programada. Después del horario de oficina y los fines de semana, llame a Easton Coach Co. al 717-396-1001.

Visitantes fuera de la ciudad por ADA

Si un visitante no tiene documentación de elegibilidad ADA de otra jurisdicción, RRTA seguirá brindando el servicio. La RRTA puede solicitar prueba de residencia y, si la discapacidad no es evidente, documentación de la discapacidad del individuo. RRTA aceptará una certificación del visitante de que no puede utilizar el transporte de ruta fija. Esto significa que la RRTA no puede exigir documentación más allá del "decir" del visitante que no puede utilizar el sistema de ruta fija. Los servicios se brindan durante cualquier combinación de 21 días durante cualquier período de 365 días a partir del primer uso del servicio por parte del visitante durante ese período de 365 días. Las reservaciones se pueden hacer utilizando el mismo proceso que los pasajeros de paratransito aprobados.

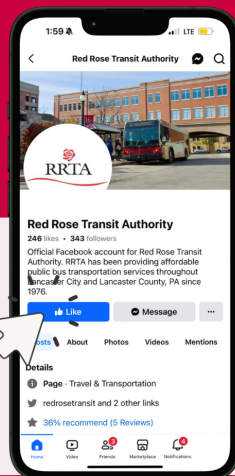

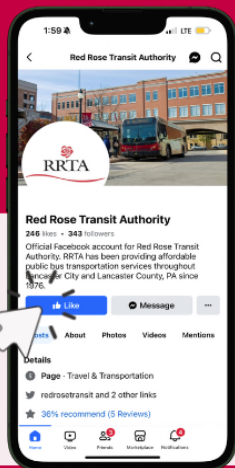

American With Disabilities Act Reasonable Modifications

On March 13, 2015, the Federal Department of Transportation issued a Final Rule affecting 49 CFR Parts 27 and 37: Transportation for Individuals With Disabilities; Reasonable Modification of Policies and Practices. The purpose behind this final rule is, "...specifically to provide that transportation entities are required to make reasonable modifications/accommodations to policies, practices, and procedures to avoid discrimination and ensure that their programs are accessible to individuals with disabilities." The modification requires Federal funding recipients make reasonable accommodations in policies, practices, or procedures, when necessary, to avoid discrimination on the basis of disability unless recipients can demonstrate that making the accommodations would fundamentally alter the nature of the service, program, or activity or result in an undue financial and administrative burden. This requirement, applying to both fixed-route and paratransit services, is effective July 13, 2015.

RRTA's Reasonable Modification request process is consistent with the ruling: (1) individuals requesting modifications are asked to describe what they need in order to use the service; (2) individuals are not required to use the term "reasonable modification" when requesting modifications or accommodations; (3) when feasible, requests for modifications should be made in advance; (4) operating personnel may make a determination for modification at the time of service—management may be consulted to grant/deny the request.

Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Modificación Razonable

El 13 de marzo de 2015, el Departamento Federal de Transporte emitió una norma definitiva que afecta a 49 CFR Partes 27 y 37: Transporte para Personas con Discapacidad; Modificación Razonable de Políticas y Prácticas. El propósito detrás de esta regla final es: "... específicamente para disponer que se necesitan entidades de transporte para hacer modificaciones razonables / alojamiento en las políticas, prácticas y procedimientos para evitar la discriminación y garantizar que sus programas sean accesibles a las personas con discapacidad." La modificación requiere beneficiarios federales de financiación hacen ajustes razonables en las políticas, prácticas o procedimientos, cuando sea necesario, para evitar la discriminación por motivos de discapacidad a menos beneficiarios pueden demostrar que lo que el alojamiento alteraría fundamentalmente la naturaleza del servicio, programa o actividad o dar lugar a una carga financiera y administrativa excesiva. Este requisito, aplicando tanto a ruta fija y servicios de transporte informal, es efectiva 13 de julio 2015.

Razonable proceso de solicitud de modificación de RRTA es coherente con la sentencia: (1) las personas que solicitan modificaciones se les pide que describan lo que necesitan para utilizar el servicio; (2) los individuos no están obligados a utilizar el término "modificación razonable" al solicitar modificaciones o adaptaciones; (3) cuando sea posible, las solicitudes de modificaciones deben hacerse con anticipación; (4) El personal que operan pueden hacer una determinación para la modificación en el momento de la gestión del servicio puede consultarse a conceder / denegar la solicitud.

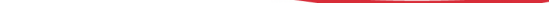
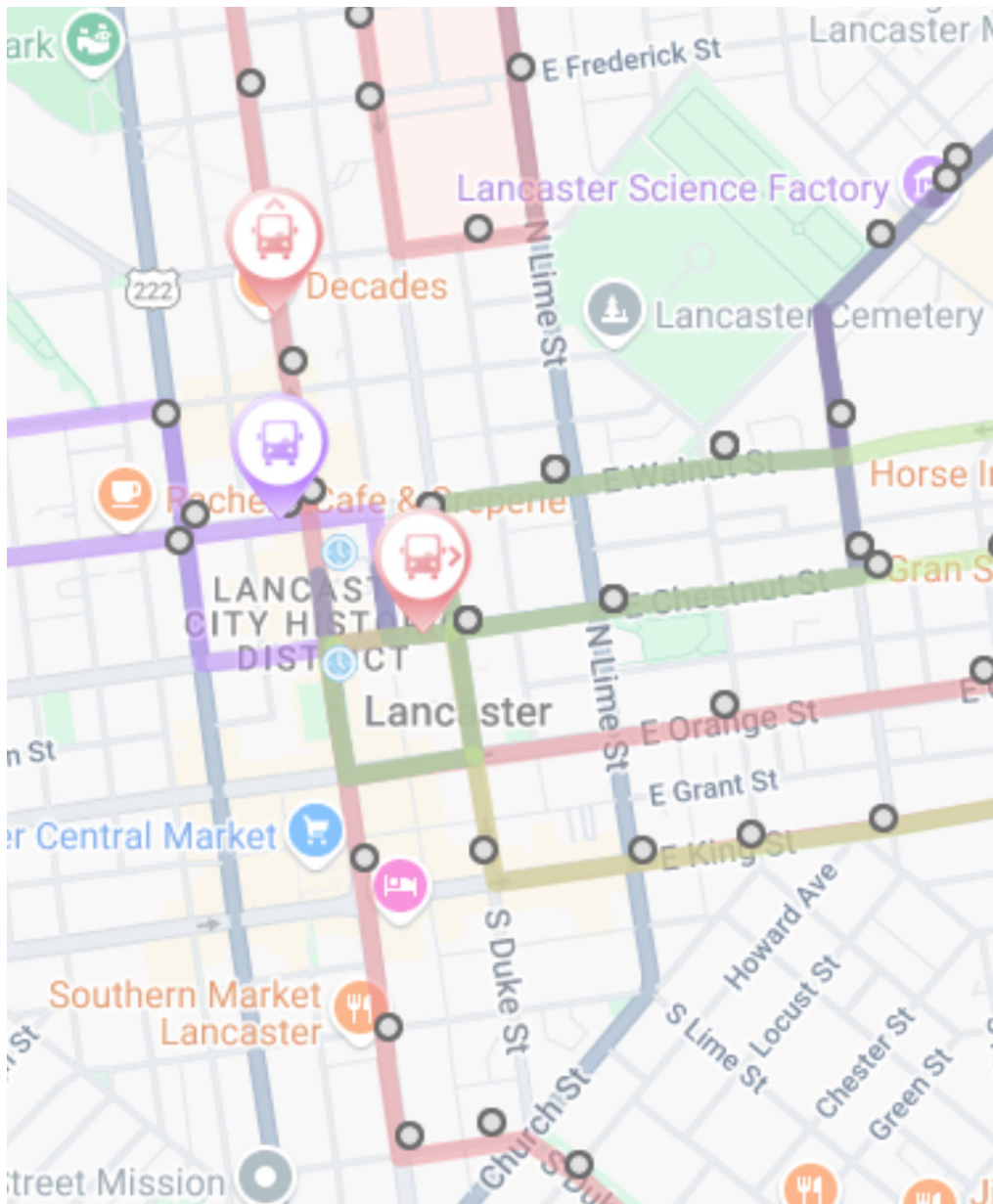
Policy Statement
